- **Remaining Balance:** This includes the balance from any unpaid water or wastewater charges on past bills.
- **Customer Charge Water:** This is the base charge for water service and the amount varies based on your meter size.
- Current Water Charges: This includes the base charge outlined above plus the cost for water usage, which is calculated at the cost per gallon and multiplied by the amount of water used.
- Customer Charge (Sewer): This is the flat base charge for wastewater service and it includes the first 1,000 gallons of wastewater usage.
- Current Sewer Charges: This includes the base charge plus the cost for wastewater usage greater than 1,000 gallons, which is calculated at the cost per gallon and multiplied by your wastewater usage. Wastewater charges are capped from May through October when customers tend to use more water.

- ICC Tax: Aqua Illinois collects this charge on behalf of the Illinois Commerce Commission, which uses these fees to fund its operation and utility oversight. The tax is based on a percentage of your total bill.
- Special Purpose Rider Charges: These charges, which apply evenly across our systems, were developed with the ICC and other utilities, and account for costs associated with COVID-19 and unpaid customer bills.
- Fire Protection Charge: This is for the installation and maintenance of public fire hydrants attached to Aqua Illinois' water mains. The amount varies based on your meter size.
- Infrastructure Surcharges: These are part of the Illinois Quality Infrastructure Program and help Aqua Illinois fund certain community infrastructure replacements for things like water mains and fire hydrants.
- City Utility Tax: This is added to customer bills on behalf of the Village of University Park, which receives these fees for municipal uses. The tax is based on a percentage of your total bill.
